First and second year students generally focus on LOWER DIVISION Concentration courses numbered 100-299.

Take UPPER DIVISION Concentration courses numbered 300+ when at least 60 units are in progress.
40 upper division units required for graduation, including 3 units upper division General Education in GE areas B, C and D.
